3. Course Summary	Dr. S. B. Das spoke to the participants about plant protection and their techniques. They talk on pesticides residues like the source for pesticide residues in our food could be through the application of pesticides on crops, with residues remaining in the fruits and vegetables or through the application of pesticides in homes to disinfect. Pesticide residues, once in our system can be the cause for several acute and chronic diseases. So removing the pesticides, as much as we can, is the first step forward.

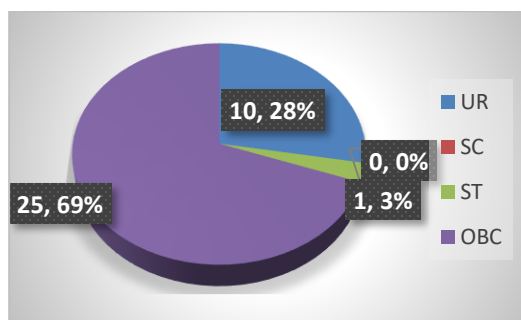
